Call for Submissions - Legal Costs Committee

Legal Profession Act 2008

Pursuant to section 278 of the *Legal Profession Act 2008* (Act), the Legal Costs Committee gives notice of its intention to conduct reviews and make determinations pursuant to the Act with respect to scales of costs set out in each of the following:

- *Legal Practitioners (Public Notaries) Determination 2017*; and
- *Legal Practitioners (Solicitors Costs) Determination 2017*; and
- *Legal Practitioners (Non-Contentious Probate Costs) Determination 2017*.

Interested persons, organisations and associations are invited to submit in writing any views they wish to have considered by the Legal Costs Committee with respect to the proposed determinations.

Any person, organisation or association may make verbal submissions on the proposed determinations. It is expected that verbal submissions will be heard at a time and place when and where the Legal Costs Committee normally meets. Notice will be given to those parties who have previously indicated their intention to make verbal submissions.
